
ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This cause came on for consideration on April 30, 2008. Appellant Robinson filed a notice of appeal with this Board on January 4, 2008. His notice of appeal did not allege with particularity any violation of the civil service law over which this Board has jurisdiction. On March 7, 2008, this Board issued a Procedural Order to Appellant Robinson, ordering him to supplement his notice of appeal with particularity as to what action he is appealing. A deadline of March 24, 2008 was given. The Procedural Order also stated that failure to submit the requested information by that date will result in his appeal being dismissed.

To date, Appellant Robinson has not submitted any additional information pursuant to this Board's Procedural Order. Therefore, it is my **RECOMMENDATION** that this appeal be **DISMISSED** to due a lack of jurisdiction since there is no justiciable issue present.
