

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration April 22, 2008, upon Appellant's filing of an appeal of her reclassification. The letter provided by Appellant notifying her of the results of her position audit was dated November 5, 2007.

I find that the State Personnel Board of Review is without jurisdiction to hear this appeal because the appeal was not filed within thirty (30) calendar days after Appellant received notice of the results of her job audit, as required by Ohio Administrative Code Section 124-1-03(C).
