
ORDER


REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration upon Appellant's filing of an appeal from the results of the job audit conducted on her position, classified as Administrative Specialist (classification number 11114).

Pursuant to O.A.C. 124-1-03(C), appeals from job reclassification decisions shall be filed, in writing, within thirty calendar days after the employee receives notice of the results of the job audit. The information contained in the record indicates that Appellant received the results of the job audit on March 19, 2008, via e-mail. Appellant filed her appeal with this Board on April 22, 2008.

Therefore, because Appellant filed her appeal thirty-four calendar days after she received notice of the results of her job audit, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the instant appeal be **DISMISSED** as untimely filed, pursuant to O.A.C. 124-1-03(C).
