





I would like to voluntarily withdraw my request for an investigation of the actions of the Hamilton County Department of Job & Family Services. Upon consultation I was informed that the issues I wanted investigated will be addressed in my companion case 09- LAY-06-0305. This filing for an investigation was due to the discovery of the Lay off and recall of two Children's Services Managers in July of 2009.

On the October 19, 2009 Pre-Hearing - this case was held in abeyance and was never even addressed at any time during this appeals process. I find that the reason for dismissal is being requested in the same error that is being made in my companion case. Since the exact same testimony and rationale is being used in both cases- the same errors exist. Therefore, I do not want this case dismissed - I would like to withdraw, and I will continue my companion case to the highest court that will hear it.
