

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This cause comes on due to a review of the information contained in the record. On June 17, 2009, this Board issued a Procedural Order instructing Appellant to provide the Board with additional information identifying the subject matter of her appeal. Such information was requested so that the Board could determine whether it had jurisdiction to consider the matter. Appellant was ordered to provide the requested information to the Board not later than 5:00 p.m., July 6, 2009. To date, no response has been received from Appellant.

Pursuant to O.A.C. 124-11-13, this Board has the authority to issue procedural orders at any time prior to the issuance of a final order. O.A.C. 124-11-13(B) provides that the failure to comply with a procedural order may result in the dismissal of a case.

Therefore, because Appellant has failed to respond as ordered by this Board to its June 17, 2009, Procedural Order, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the instant appeal be **DISMISSED**, in accordance with O.A.C. 124-11-13.
