**LIFTING OF STAY / ISSUANCE OF FINAL ORDER**


This matter came on for consideration upon the Board's December 1, 2011 issuance of a Stay Order in this matter that ordered the City of Amherst and the City of Amherst Civil Service Commission to comply with various specific instructions contained therein and to provide notice of that compliance to the Board on or before February 3, 2012. On January 25, 2012, the Mayor of the City of Amherst, David A. Taylor, provided said documentation to the Board. On January 26, 2012, Appellant filed Appellant's Response "Re: Compliance with Board Stay Order Case 11-INV-04-0112". On January 30, 2012, Appellee filed Appellee's Response to Appellant's Filing Regarding Appellee's Compliance with the State Personnel Board of Review's Stay Order.

It is noted that, in Appellant's Response, referenced, above, Appellant directs the Board to several conversations in which he recently participated concerning lateral transfers. The Board did not review the subject matter of lateral transfers in the instant investigation. If Appellant has concerns regarding same, it is suggested that Appellant could formally bring those concerns to the City of Amherst Civil Service Commission for their consideration. If Appellant were to do so, and if the City of Amherst Civil Service Commission were to provide Appellant with a response that objectively appeared to be in conflict with the requisite provisions set forth in R.C. Chapter 124., then Appellant could file a request for investigation with the Board along with requisite documentation concerning the alleged violation, consistent with R.C. 124.40.




