

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on July 23, 2012. A record hearing was scheduled to take place on that date at 10:00 a.m. at this Board's offices; that record hearing was converted to a pre-hearing and notice of such conversion was served upon the parties on July 12, 2012. Appellee appeared before the Board on July 23, 2012, through its designee, Human Resources Consultant Marc Stoffel, and was represented by Amanda L. Scheeser, Assistant Attorney General. Appellant failed to appear and Appellee moved to dismiss this appeal.

I find that notice of the hearing was initially served upon Appellant on May 10, 2012, and notice of the conversion of the record hearing to a pre-hearing was served on Appellant on July 12, 2012, by regular mail. No good cause has been shown for Appellant's failure to appear.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that Appellee's motion be **GRANTED** and the appeal be **DISMISSED**.
