

**ORDER**


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that this investigation be **DISMISSED**.





**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration September 19, 2012, upon Appellant's filing of a request for an investigation.

I find that the State Personnel Board of Review is without jurisdiction to consider Appellant's request for an investigation because the request was not filed within six (6) months from an alleged violation, as required by administrative rule 124-1-03(F) of the Ohio Administrative Code. In her request for an investigation, Appellant Snyder stated she received notice of her involuntary disability separation on September 8, 2011 and her request for an investigation was not filed with this Board until July 26, 2012, approximately ten (10) months later. Also, Appellant Snyder appealed her involuntary disability separation on the same date, making it untimely. She cannot try to file an investigation request in the hopes of "back-dooring" an untimely appeal of her involuntary disability separation.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that this investigation request be **DISMISSED**.
