

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the instant appeal is **DISMISSED** due to this Board's lack of jurisdiction.





REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This cause comes on for consideration pursuant to Appellee's Motion to Dismiss, filed with this Board on May 17, 2012. Appellant has filed no memorandum *contra*.

Based upon the uncontroverted information contained in the record, I find that Appellant filed an appeal of her removal from employment with Appellee, the Cuyahoga County Sheriff, with this Board on January 20, 2012.

Effective January 1, 2011, Cuyahoga County began operating under the terms of a county charter. Pursuant to Article IX, section 9.02(1) of the Charter, the county's Human Resource Commission has:

(1) Responsibility for the resolution or disposition of all personnel matters, with authority to appoint hearing officers to hear all employee appeals previously under the jurisdiction of the State Personnel Board of Review. . .

Accordingly, this Board no longer possesses jurisdiction over employees falling under the auspices of the Cuyahoga County Charter after January 1, 2011. Appellant Williams stated that she was removed effective January 10, 2012, therefore, her appeal lies with the Human Resource Commission and not with the State Personnel Board of Review.
