


ORDER

This matter came on for consideration upon Appellee's Rescission letter indicating that Appellant's original removal order has been rescinded pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 124-3-03(C). We note that Appellee's Rescission letter states that Appellant was reinstated effective October 5, 2012, with wages in arrears fully paid. We further note that Appellee issued a new O.R.C. 124.34 Order of Removal to Appellant terminating her employment effective November 17, 2012. (Case No. 12-REM-11-0248). That case has been assigned to an administrative law judge for a hearing on the merits.


