

**ORDER**


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration upon Appellant's filing of an appeal from an Involuntary Disability Separation. A pre-hearing was scheduled to take place before this Board on February 14, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Appellee was present through its designee, Amy Parmi, Labor and Human Resources Counsel, and was represented by Amanda L. Scheeser, Assistant Attorney General. Appellant failed to appear and Appellee moved to dismiss this appeal.
