

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.


REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on April, 18, 2014. A Status Conference was scheduled to take place before this Board on April 17, 2014 at 10:00 a.m. Appellee appeared before the Board at that time through its designee, Marla K. Burton, Assistant Chief Legal Counsel, and was represented by Timothy E. Miller and E. Joseph D'Andrea, Assistant Attorneys General.
