



I hereby wish to withdraw my case against Opportunities for Ohioans with Disabilities/Ohio Rehabilitation Commission. My reasons are as follows.

I have received Notice of Appearance and Request for Witness and Document List from the Ohio Attorney General's Office. I have no witnesses and the only document I could produce would be a copy of an e-mail to Human Resources requesting to review the results of the internal test for the Fiscal Specialist 1 position, which was never responded to.

One of my largest concerns was whether internal tests of individual agencies were deemed as civil service tests and if this practice replaces the previous civil service testing and certification practice conducted through Ohio Department of Administrative Services. An answer to this question should not have to involve a formal hearing.

Sufficient evidence to support my other allegations will require lengthy private investigation which has not been completed.

Please cancel my request for investigation and supply this information to the Ohio Attorney General's office.
