

ORDER


These matters came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeals.





REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

These causes came on due to Appellant's April 26, 2013 filing of appeals. Regrettably, it appears Appellant passed away very near that same date, specifically on May 3, 2013. This is evidenced by Appellee's May 13, 2013 filing of a Suggestion of Death and accompanying obituary of Appellant.
