

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration due to the February 26, 2013 occurrence of a pre-hearing in this and related matters affecting employees of Appellee Department of Job and Family Services. Eight Appellants appeared for pre-hearing, as did both Appellees through their respective designees. However, Appellant Jeffrey D. Calhoun and one additional Appellant failed to appear.

I find notice was properly served on Appellant Calhoun on February 15, 2013, by regular mail, and no good cause has yet been shown for his failure to appear. Should Appellant Calhoun have good cause as to why he did not appear for pre-hearing, he will need to provide that rationale to this Board in the form of objections filed with the Board within 10 calendar days of Appellant's receipt of this Report and Recommendation, or the Board will likely dismiss his instant appeal for Appellant Calhoun's failure to appear at his February 26, 2013 scheduled pre-hearing.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the State Personnel Board of Review **DISMISS** the instant appeal for Appellant Jeffrey D. Calhoun's failure to appear, pursuant to O.A.C. 124-11-19.
