





Dear Judge Sprague:

This letter is to indicate in writing my decision to withdraw my reclassification appeal. I have appreciated the opportunities to further discuss and present materials regarding my role and the appropriate classification of my current position here at BWC. It is disappointing that feedback I have received reflects that the additional information I provided has been unpersuasive. Given that feedback, and my understanding of the next steps in this process, I have determined that it is in my and the agency's best interest to withdraw my appeal. Given the probability of the end result would be the potential further erosion of the focus on and successful ability to execute on the critical business unit tasks, I have determine such is best to avoid. I need to be able to proceed on the MCO unit assignments and priority projects that are in progress and mission critical to our agency's success. This process has provided great insights to me on the importance of being able to clearly explain and show a nexus between job duties and expectations of a job as specified in classification expectations.

While I do believe that the work I have performed over the past 21 years with great pride, passion and diligence reflects the higher level expectations of a classification different than what I have been re-classed into or subsequently identified as a potential classification, I recognize the challenge in others understanding that belief. As I continue to work here at BWC, I will work closely with my management team to strengthen the appropriate reflection of my daily tasks and their impact on the Health Partnership Program System.
