

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on May 6, 2014, due to the scheduled hearing regarding the reclassification of Appellant Chaney's position with Appellee, Department of Insurance. Appellees, Department of Insurance and Department of Administrative Services, were present at the hearing through their respective designees. Appellant Chaney failed to appear. Appellee, Department of Insurance moved to dismiss this appeal due to Appellant's failure to appear.

A review of the information contained in the record indicates that the notice of hearing was properly served on Appellant Chaney on February 21, 2014, by regular U.S. mail, and no good cause has been shown for his failure to appear. Should Appellant Chaney have good cause as to why he did not appear for the scheduled hearing, he will need to provide that rationale to this Board in the form of written objections filed with the Board within ten calendar days of his receipt of this Report and Recommendation.

Therefore, since no good cause has been shown for Appellant's failure to appear, I **RECOMMEND** that the motion to dismiss be granted and that this appeal be **DISMISSED**, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code Rule 124-11-19(A).
