



Dear Sir or Madam,

I am writing to address my appeal dated November 7, 2013, case number 2013-REC-11-0344. Pursuant to the Procedural Order from the State Personnel Board of Review (Board) dated January 10, 2014, I wish to withdraw my appeal.

My appeal was submitted in order to address the disparity between my allocation following the Management Analyst Supervisor 1 and 2 study and the classification that appeared to be more appropriate for the duties as outlined in my Position Description. My allocation placed me in the Insurance Contract Analyst 1 (CA1) level while my appeal sought to specify the basis upon which the Insurance Contract Analyst 2 (CA2) level would be more appropriate.

However, the Procedural Order specified that the "Board does not possess the authority to move an employee (who DAS has moved from an exempt designation into a bargaining unit due to a review determination) from one classification in the bargaining unit into another classification that still falls in the bargaining unit." As the CA1 and CA2 are both bargaining unit classifications, the appeal would not be the appropriate avenue to address the matter of my classification.

Consequently, this matter is being resolved thru a Reclassification Agreement between the Ohio Department of Insurance and the Ohio Civil Service Employees Association, Local 11, AFSCME, AFLCIO in which "The Department of Insurance agrees to reclassify Employee from position number 20080353, Insurance Contract Analyst 1... to position number 20080353, Insurance Contract Analyst 2".

Due to this Reclassification Agreement and the Procedural Order, please accept this as notification that I wish to withdraw the appeal.
