



NOTICE OF SETTLEMENT

Appellee, Ohio Department of Mental Health & Addiction Services (“MHAS”) s/h/a Department of Mental Health, Summit Behavioral Healthcare, by and through counsel does hereby give notice to the State Personnel Board of Review (“SPBR”) that MHAS and Appellant, Mr. Rick Johnson (“Johnson”), entered into a settlement agreement (“Agreement”) on January 26, 2014. Included in the Agreement is a complete release and waiver of any and all legal claims or causes of action that Johnson may have against MHAS up to and including the date on which the Agreement was fully executed. Also included in the Agreement is Johnson’s resignation effective May 16, 2013, in exchange for MHAS’s rescission of Johnson’s removal, which gave rise to the appeal currently before the SPBR. Because the removal currently before the SPBR has been rescinded, the instant appeal is moot. Therefore, MHAS respectfully requests the SPBR to dismiss Johnson’s appeal *sua sponte*.


