

**ORDER**


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.



**REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION**

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This matter came on for consideration on October 3, 2014. A pre-hearing was scheduled to take place before this Board on October 1, 2014 at 10:00am. The matter was converted from a record hearing previously scheduled for that same time and date, with an accommodation being made for Appellant to appear by telephone.

Appellee appeared in person before the Board on October 1, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. and was represented by Matthew J. Karam and Erin Butcher-Lyden, Assistant Attorneys General. The Board was not able to contact Appellant by telephone at the time of the pre-hearing, and Appellant did not contact the Board by telephone. Although a message was left on Appellant's answering machine at that time requesting that Appellant contact the Board, he failed to do so either on the date of pre-hearing or subsequently. At the pre-hearing, Appellee made a motion to dismiss the instant appeal based upon Appellant's failure to move forward.

I find notice of the pre-hearing was properly served on Appellant on September 4, 2014, by regular mail, and no good cause has been shown for Appellant's failure to appear.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** the Appellee's motion be **GRANTED** and the appeal be **DISMISSED**.
