

ORDER


This matter came on for consideration on the Report and Recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge in the above-captioned appeal.

Wherefore, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the instant appeal is **DISMISSED** for a lack of jurisdiction.






REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This cause comes on for consideration upon the filing of Appellee's Motion to Dismiss, filed on April 21, 2014. To date, Appellant Papp has not filed a memorandum *contra*.

As is stated in Appellee's Motion to Dismiss, Cuyahoga County is a Charter form of government and pursuant to Article IX, Section 9.0(1) of the Charter, the Cuyahoga County Personnel Review Commission is the entity who has the authority to hear appeals from employees of Cuyahoga county. While those employees previously fell under the jurisdiction of this Board, with the implementation of the Charter, this Board no longer possess jurisdiction over employees of Cuyahoga County.

Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the instant appeal be **DISMISSED** for a lack of jurisdiction.
