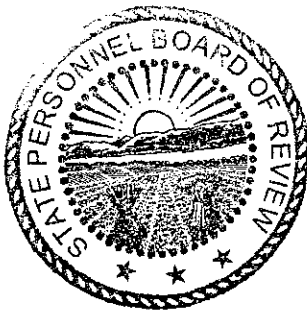


REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION
