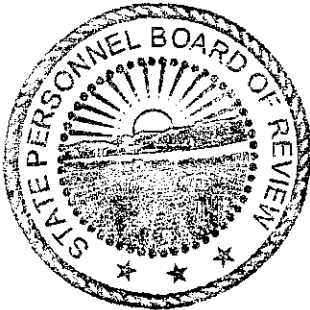



With your attorney's permission, I am writing to inform you that Ohio State University has rescinded the 4-day suspension issued to you effective February 1, 2, 5, and 6, 2007, and has reissued discipline in the form of a 2-day suspension. Your personnel records will therefore reflect a 2-day suspension in lieu of a 4-day suspension. In addition, you will be reimbursed for days of back-pay.

So you are aware, the State Personnel Board of Review does not have authority to exercise jurisdiction over appeals of less than 24 hours. Any appeal of a two-day suspension will therefore be dismissed by the Board.
