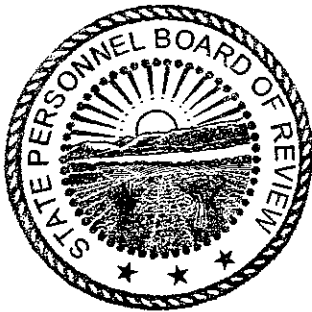




REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

To the Honorable State Personnel Board of Review:

This cause comes on for consideration pursuant to Appellee's Motions to Dismiss, filed in the above-referenced appeals on May 19, 2008. Appellant filed no memoranda *contra*.

Appellant filed an appeal with this Board of his alleged removal and reduction. Appellee asserted in its Motion to Dismiss that Appellant was neither removed nor reduced pursuant to R.C. 124.34, but was, in fact, laid off pursuant to an abolishment of his position. Appellant has pending before this Board an appeal of his layoff and position abolishment (SPBR Case Nos. 08-ABL-03-0074 and 08-LAY-03-0075).

Accordingly, based upon the uncontroverted evidence contained in the record, I find that Appellant was neither removed, nor reduced pursuant to R.C. 124.34. Therefore, I respectfully **RECOMMEND** that the instant appeal be **DISMISSED** as moot.
